Programme Introduction





1. Purpose

We are committed to high quality training and competence development. We work with our students to help them succeed and gain the professional qualification they are seeking. 2. Target Group

The programme is designed for professionals aspiring for the role of internal coach within their organization, regardless their experience with coaching. Our students comes from various backgrounds, like HR and L&D professionals, consultants, medical professionals, managers, agile coaches and SCRUM Masters.

3. Ultimate Result

The overall aim of the programme is for students to develop the core competences required to be an effective internal coach:

- Understanding and practical application of 8 coaching competencies according to the International Coach Federation (ICF), in the context of practical application in an internal corporate environment
- Understanding psychological processes manifesting in a coaching relationship, psychology of motivation and unconscious dynamics in interpersonal communication
- Understanding the coaching process in an internal environment
- Preparation of participants to perform the role of in-house coaching coach and coaching skills lecturer
- Learn knowledge and skills from two important directions in coaching: solution-focused and psychodynamic coaching solutions (working with unconscious patterns of behaviour or communication in the coaching process)





Important part of the programme is supporting the organisation on creating the culture of internal coaching. We build on our extensive experience in this field and support clients to identify communication strategies to introduce the programme to the employees, as well as create strategical alliances with already existing developmental initiatives to boost the effectiveness of employee development infrastructure in the organisation.





4. The Programme Content

The programme has been designed to support the creation of a community of internal coaches within the organisation. The programme consists of 5 modules, 10 mentoring hours and a half-day session on coaching supervision.

5. The Programme Overview

• Form of interactive, experiential learning in hybrid format:

- o training days take place live
- o individual mentoring lessons take place online
- o group mentoring lessons take place live
- Self-study is managed individually by each participant during the duration of the training program (self-study materials will be provided to the students after each module)
- Training provides 60 hours of coaching education, broken down as follows:
 - o 5 one-day modules (40 hours of education in total)
 - o 1 day final examination (representing 8 hours of education)
 - Self-study (a total of 12 hours of education)
- The programme also includes 10 mentoring sessions to support individual learning divided as follows:
 - 1 x 1 hour group mentoring
 - o 3 x 1 hour individual mentoring
 - 2 x 3 hours group mentoring in the form of a practical workshop

• During the programme, participants receive 35 hours of experience, of which 14 hours are covered within training

days and 21 hours is individual practice outside training days

• The training is completed by the final exam, during which the theoretical and practical competencies of the participants will be verified

• Three months after the final exam, there will be a 3-hours group supervision for graduates to help them reflect on their work as an internal coaches and support mutual learning

*Training can be delivered in Slovak or English language.





6. Time Schedule for 2023

The training is delivered in an in-house format; therefore, the schedule will be agreed with the respective organisation.

7. Programme Costs

- o 5 x 8-hours training modules

- o Final exam with written feedback

- 3 x 30 min consultation with the Programme Manager in the client's organisation responsible for the implementation of internal coaching programme
